Question 1

Each candidate should be provided with:

- (i) a 2 mm thick slice of a fresh young tender garden cucumber labelled **P**
- (ii) a 5 mm thick slice of a fresh young tender garden cucumber labelled **P**
- (iii) a 5 mm thick slice of a partly ripe tomato labelled **Q**

N.B These transverse sections should be prepared 30 minutes before the examination.

- (iv) Magnifying glass / hand lens $\times 10$
- (v) Scalpel blade
- (vi) 30 cm³ of distilled water in a petri dish labelled distilled water
- (vii) 30 cm³ of 30% sucrose solution in a petri dish labelled sucrose solution
- (viii) 15 \times 15 cm white ceramic tile

Question 2

Each candidate should be provided with:

- (i) An onion slice ($\frac{1}{4}$ of a bulb) in a beaker of distilled water.
- (ii) 2 blank microscope slides
- (iii) 2 cover slips
- (iv) 1 dropper
- (v) Light microscope fitted with $\times 10$ and $\times 40$
- (vi) Iodine solution (10 ml)
- (vii) 2 filter papers
- (viii) 50 ml distilled water in a wash bottle
- (ix) Scalpel blade
